INSTRUCTIONS

1. Submission of the two page **PRE-APPLICATION** form.
2. Submission of **OFFICIAL TRANSCRIPTS** of all academic work reflecting credit hours the applicant has completed beyond the secondary school level.

Southeastern alumni may request an official copy of their academic transcript be sent on-campus as part of an application for another degree at Southeastern. These requests are processed through Southeastern's Registrar's Office. Please note that your signature is required for us to release your records.

Please visit "Alumni Resources" under the "Alumni & Friends" tab at www.sebts.edu to complete the Transcript Request Form. Please allow five (5) business days for your request to be processed; your request will be processed in the order it was received.

3. The Director of the Doctor of Ministry Program will **INTERVIEW** the prospective applicant to receive counsel about the program and the admissions criteria in order to determine the prospect's potential for acceptance into the program. The interview may be held, by telephone or in person, after receipt of a completed pre-application packet and all required, official transcripts.

Note: All forms should be submitted to the attention of Doctor of Ministry Office.

Applicants who successfully complete the pre-application process are invited to complete the full application form in order to continue the admission evaluation process. The application process may be terminated at any time by either the applicant or by the Director.

**Doctor of Ministry Program
Pre-Application**

Applicants for the Doctor of Ministry Program at Southeastern Seminary initially follow a pre-application process. The successful applicant must have earned a high GPA on Master of Divinity work, followed by at least three years of vocational experience in full-time ministry. Doctor of Ministry students must be actively engaged in ministry for the duration of their program of study.

The pre-application must include a complete professional resume and official transcripts. When these documents have been received, they will be reviewed by the program director. Upon the recommendation of the director, regular application forms will be provided, and the next stage of the application process will begin. A full program description is provided once admitted.
