SEBTS' partnership with Uganda Baptist Seminary (UBS) has thrived for many years. The current cohort is our third cohort of students. This particular cohort is made up of men and women who hope to stand firm in the face of the animism, radical Islam, and prosperity gospel found in East Africa. Clive Jarvis, a professor for Church History and Baptist History who teaches adjunctively for SEBTS states, "Our current crop of 20 Masters students are the future of theological education in East Africa. Thanks to our partnership with SEBTS we have been able to go beyond identifying the Theologian/Trainers of the future we have begun to prepare them for the task." The cohort is made up of leaders from Rwanda, Kenya, Uganda, and Tanzania. Most of these students are current or potential faculty or administrators in theological education entities or in UBS itself. Jarvis states, "If theological education is to genuinely become the responsibility of the indigenous believers of East Africa, it is essential that we train a generation of African theologians to the highest international Standards. The Masters course provided by SEBTS is vital as a stepping stone toward identifying those students able to move to the next level."
