

Red River Baptist Association Seminary Scholarship

(Applications must be in the Red River Baptist Association Office by June 1st)

1. Application will be accepted from Arkansans attending one of the following seven seminaries.
 - Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary Fort Worth, TX
 - Southern Baptist Theological Seminary, Louisville, KY
 - Southeastern Baptist Theological Seminary, Wake Forest, North Carolina
 - Golden Gate Baptist Theological Seminary, Mill Valley, CA
 - New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, New Orleans, LA
 - Mid-Western Baptist Theological Seminary, Kansas City, MO
 - Mid-America Baptist Theological Seminary, Cordova, TN
2. The student must be enrolled to attend or be attending as a full time Student. With at least a 2.0 GPA.
3. The student must be a male and have a vocational call to be a pastor, preacher or evangelist.
4. The Student must be an active member or have been an active member of a Southern Baptist Church in Arkansas before starting Seminary.
5. The Fund shall distribute \$6,000.00 semi-annually. Which will go directly to the seminary of the scholarship recipient for any tuition and fees, room and board, textbooks cost, for the student. Any remaining funds shall be distributed directly to the Scholarship Recipient.
6. Scholarships will be awarded for one year. A recipient must reapply for consideration for a scholarship for a subsequent year. Preference will be given to individuals who are members of a Southern Baptist Church in Red River Baptist Association, at least prior to beginning seminary.
7. A recipient's seminary will be asked to confirm the recipient's enrollment, attendance and status at the institution.
8. A recipient must, as a condition to receiving assistance, execute a promissory note evidencing intent and obligation to reimburse the Arkansas Baptist Foundation in full measure should the recipient fail to pursue a career with a Southern Baptist Church or Southern Baptist Evangelistic Organization.
9. Student recipient will be chosen by August 1 of each year.
