

Recycling in Campus Housing

Commingled Recycling

Combine recyclables in one container without taking time to separate. Please empty containers as much as possible. Below is a list of items which may be placed in the commingled recycling dumpsters:

- ◆ Plastic items numbered 1-7
- ◆ Any color glass except blue
- ◆ All white /colored paper with any color ink
- ◆ Computer paper, blueprints, phone books
- ◆ Copy paper, any color
- ◆ Sticky Notes, Index cards
- ◆ Envelopes. (if it has a clear window, the clear material must be removed)
- ◆ Fax paper
- ◆ Cereal box type paper
- ◆ Notebook paper, personal stationary, posters
- ◆ Pamphlets and brochures (OK if glossy)
- ◆ Paperback books, magazines with glue or stapled binding
- ◆ Construction paper, brown craft paper or envelopes
- ◆ Newspaper & newspaper insert ads
- ◆ Paper plates, paper towels, napkins which are TOTAL- LY clean
- ◆ Aluminum cans
- ◆ Metal food cans (rinsed and labels removed)

Corrugated cardboard should be flattened and placed in the cardboard recycling bins located at Flaherty Farms or the gravel lot across from the Sharing Shop.



Items NOT allowed in Recycling Bins

- ◆ Facial tissue
- ◆ Photographs or photography paper
- ◆ Any paper coated with a waxy material
- ◆ Paperclips
- ◆ Loose staples
- ◆ Foil paper and foil wrappers
- ◆ Foil linings inside food containers/boxes

Items NOT allowed in Trash Dumpsters



- ◆ Paint
- ◆ Tires
- ◆ Wood
- ◆ Pallets
- ◆ Lead-acid batteries
- ◆ Medical waste
- ◆ Hazardous waste
- ◆ Yard waste
- ◆ Construction debris
- ◆ Fluorescent light bulbs and thermostats that contain mercury
- ◆ Computer equipment including laptops, desktops, monitors, printers, scanners, mice, keyboards and televisions
- ◆ Household appliances, mattresses and furniture
- ◆ Used oil and motor vehicle oil filters
- ◆ Antifreeze
- ◆ Aluminum cans
- ◆ Plastic containers that have a neck smaller than the body of the container
- ◆ Oyster shells

Many of these items can be taken to Wake County Convenience Sites.
