#### **Narrative Block 4 Kernel**

Matt 11:2–6 //16:13-20: The question posed by the disciples of John, "Are you the one who is to come, or are we to wait for another"? (11:2-6) // Jesus' question to his own disciples on the same topic of His identity, "But who do you say that I am?" (16:13-20)

#### Narrative Block 5 Kernel

Matt 16:21–28 // 20:17–34 featuring the pattern: 1) a passion prediction followed by 2) an ill-advised rebuke or request from a disciple, followed by 3) a monologue by Jesus on the nature of true discipleship.

#### Narrative Block 6 Kernel

Matt 21:12–22: The temple cleansing and the cursing of the fig tree, an event against which the temple cleansing is juxtaposed

#### Narrative Block 7 Kernel

Matt 27:45–28:10: The crucifixion and the resurrection of Jesus

Cosmic sign (heaven): Darkness covers the earth  $(\tau \dot{\eta} \nu \gamma \tilde{\eta} \nu)$  (27:45)

Jesus' cry of abandonment (27:46) Hostile witnesses (27:47–49)

The death of Jesus (27:50)

Cosmic sign (earth): [Καὶ ἰδοὺ.] veil rent, earthquake, tombs open (27:51–53)

Soldier's fear and cry of amazement (27:54)

Sympathetic female witnesses (27:55–56)

The burial of Jesus (27:57–66)

Cosmic sign (earth): [Καὶ ἰδοὺ.] earthquake and angel of the Lord (28:2–3)

Soldier's fear and become lifeless (28:4)

Female witnesses addressed by angel (28:5–7)

The physical appearance of Jesus (28:8–10)
