No other member of the Old Testament subcommittee ever challenged House on this and seemed merely to go along to get along with a colleague. This meeting took place in San Antonio, Texas, at the Marriott Riverwalk Hotel, on Thursday, November 18, 2004. Paige Patterson, Robert Cole, and David Jones attended as observers.
