DONATION GUIDELINES

ITEMS WE ACCEPT

- In season, gently used and CLEAN clothing, shoes and accessories
- Non-perishable canned or boxed food (unopened/current date)
- Household supplies/décor, including bedding, curtains, towels, sm/med size rugs
- Kitchen supplies – pots and pans, dishes, utensils, etc
- Office/school supplies – notebooks, paper, pens/pencils
- Flat screen TVs, laptops, phones (memory wiped and usable)
- SMALL appliances (CLEAN and functioning)
- SMALL furniture (i.e. end table or chair) *when space is available*
- SMALL electronics, computers, tech in working condition
- Toys and games (unbroken, with all parts), sporting goods
- Books/media

ITEMS WE DO NOT ACCEPT

- Out of season, worn out/DIRTY clothing w/rips, tears, stains, odor, mold, pet hair
- Clothing with business emblems or DATES (from concerts/events)
- Out of date, opened or perishable food items
- Breast pumps, car seats, cribs, play pens, highchairs, strollers
- Mattresses
- Bikes or helmets
- Tube TVs or used printers
- LARGE or heavy furniture or appliances
- Stuffed animals (unless machine washable or brand new)
- Hazardous, dangerous or recalled items
- Broken, missing parts or needing repair items
- Pollutant items such as chemicals, paint, gas, or anything flammable
- Pet supplies

WHAT is the Share Shop?

The Share Shop is a ministry that strives to support the mission of SEBTS/Judson College by supplying resources of necessary clothing and household goods to our seminary community at no charge. The Share Shop functions through the efforts of volunteers, providing opportunity for equipping students to serve the church and fulfill the Great Commission through mentoring and discipleship as faculty, staff and students serve together.

To provide these resources, donations are received during posted days/hours. Volunteers then sort, shelve, hang and display donations for the convenience of our shoppers.

WHO can shop?

Students, alumni, staff and faculty along with their immediate families.

*Immediate family is defined as:
spouse and children*

HOW to shop?

- Each shopper/family must present a SEBTS ID.
- Each adult and child may fill one generous bag and each family unit may take an additional large item (appliance, furniture, bedding set, etc).
- For exceptions to this shopping limit, speak to the volunteer in charge regarding your needs.

WHO can volunteer?

All who are part of the SEBTS community may volunteer during scheduled SERVE hours. There are age restrictions on children in the shop during serve hours.

Whenever the shop is open and volunteers are present to receive donations. Never leave a donation on the porch or yard – all donations must be placed inside donation room. Special arrangements can be made with the coordinator for receiving large donations or receiving donations at a time other than the regular schedule.
